Procedural stages experienced by Guests of Al-Rahman benefiting from Makkah Route Initiative:

1



Biometric data collection for the Guests of Al-Rahman benefiting from the initiative, ensuring that they meet the health and preventive requirements and obtain the Hajj visa Electronically

2



Sorting and tagging the luggages, by registering it under the passenger's name at the departure terminal, and issuing the boarding pass.

3



Finalizing the entry procedures into the Kingdom by the Passports team at the initiative's designated terminal prior to departure from the pilgrims' home-country airports, and allowing them to board the aircraft and proceed to the arrival terminal in Jeddah and Madinah.

4



The arrival of Guests of Al-Rahman to the designated terminal for the initiative in the Kingdom, and transfer them to their accommodations directly.

5



Luggages to be delivered directly to the pilgrims' accommodations, eliminating the need to wait for it at the arrival terminals.
